Call to Order: Allen Murray, Co-Chair, called the meeting to order at 2:06 p.m. and asked for a moment of reflection

Approval of Agenda: <u>Motion #1</u>: it was moved and seconded (Mica, Ledbetter) to approve the agenda. **Motion carried.**

Review Meeting Goals: Williams explained that the goal for the meeting was to make recommendations regarding the FY 2021 Level, Increase and Decrease Allocation Scenarios. Recommendations are to be presented at the Public Hearing which will be recorded later this month.

Public Comment: Vargas said he gave public comment at the Quality Improvement Meeting regarding emergency housing for those who may need it after March 1, 2021. Emergency housing is currently provided by the Ryan White administered COVID-19 CARES funding. He is very disappointed that the Quality Improvement committee did not vote to add housing to the service definition for Emergency Financial Assistance. The Council stopped funding emergency housing in 2005 creating a gap that needs to be filled. These funds are greatly needed after hurricanes and other emergency circumstances to help people living with HIV who have been displaced from their homes.

FY 2021 Service Definitions: Williams presented the summary of How to Best Meet the Need recommendations from the Quality Improvement Committee. See attached. She said that the motion regarding the addition of housing to Emergency Financial Assistance-Other will need to go back to Quality Improvement for additional discussion.

Updates from the Administrative Agents

Ryan White Part A/MAI: Martin said reports were in the meeting packet. She said to expect carryover funds, including some from the administrative budget. There were big shifts in MAI funds during the final quarter. ADAP is now covering some non-HIV medications for things like high blood pressure so there is less use of the Local Pharmacy Assistance Program (LPAP). Usage of medical case management was also decreased this year. A lot of the emergency financial assistance increase was from one provider.

Ryan White Part B and State Services Funding: Johnson-Fairly said their reports were also included in the packet. She reminded the committee that there was a reduction in the State Services award for FY2021.

Draft Allocations for FY 2021 Part A/MAI, Part B and State Services Funding

Mica asked the committee to keep COVID-19 in mind when determining the allocations. Murray said that the increased unemployment may also increase the use of Ryan White services. Martin said that there is no updated on Minority AIDS Initiative funds and as of right now she isn't sure what to expect in the future regarding the Ending the Epidemic funding. Johnson-Fairley said there is no update to State Services Rebate funds other than it should be called State Rebate since it is connected to Part B and not State Services. The committee began to compare FY 2019 expenditures against FY 2019 allocations in order to adjust the allocations for each service category.

Level Funding Scenario for Ryan White Part A, MAI, Part B and State Services Funding.

Approve the attached Ryan White Part A, MAI, Part B, and State Services Funding FY 2021 Level Funding Scenario.

MOTION 2: MAI Increase / Decrease Scenarios

Decrease Funding Scenario for Ryan White Minority AIDS Initiative (MAI).

Primary care subcategories will be decreased by the same percent. This applies to the total amount of service dollars available.

Increase Funding Scenario for Ryan White Minority AIDS Initiative (MAI).

Primary care subcategories will be increased by the same percent. This applies to the total amount of service dollars available.

MOTION 3: Part A Increase / Decrease Scenarios

Decrease Funding Scenario for Ryan White Part A Funding.

All service categories except subcategories 1.g, 2.h, 2.i, 2.j, and 10 will be decreased by the same percent. This applies to the total amount of service dollars available.

Increase Funding Scenario for Ryan White Part A Funding.

- Step 1: Allocate first \$200,000 to Medical Case Management (category 2). Subcategory to be determined by the Administrative Agent, with consideration to MAI allocations under MCM and final quarter adjustments.
- Step 2: Allocate the next \$100,000 to Health Insurance Assistance Program (category 5).
- Step 3: Allocate the next \$100,000 to Local Pharmacy Assistance Program Untargeted (category 3.b).
- Step 4: Any remaining increase in funds following application of Steps 1, 2, and 3 will be allocated by the Ryan White Planning Council, with prioritization given to new programs.

MOTION 4: Part B and State Services Increase/Decrease Scenario

Decrease Funding Scenario for Ryan White Part B and State Services Funding.

A decrease in funds of any amount will be allocated by the Ryan White Planning Council after the notice of grant award is received.

Increase Funding Scenario for Ryan White Part B and State Services Funding.

- Step 1: Allocate the first \$200,000 to be divided evenly between Oral Health General Oral Health (category 4.a.) and Oral Health Prosthodontics (category 4.b.).
- Step 2: Allocate the next \$200,000 to Health Insurance Assistance Program (category 5).
- Step 3: Any remaining increase in funds following application of Steps 1 and 2 will be allocated by the Ryan White Planning Council after the notice of grant award is received.

Call to Order: Bobby Cruz, Co-Chair, called the meeting to order at 12:08 p.m. and asked for a moment of reflection.

Adoption of the Agenda: *Motion #1*: it was moved and seconded (Turner, Murray) to adopt the agenda. **Motion carried.**

Public Comment: Ann Robison, Montrose Center (COI) said that medical case management and service linkage case managers are set to be reduced due to under-utilization which is mostly in the public clinic, but the decrease is across the board. Community based organizations have requested more funding so to cut them doesn't seem equitable. The increase in primary care clients will result in more service linkage and medical case management usage. If the category must be cut, cut it in areas that have actually underspent funds. Diane Arms, Avenue 360, read the attached comments submitted by Dr. Flash at Avenue 360.

Updates from Administrative Agents

Ryan White Part A/MAI: None.

Ryan White Part B/State Services: Turner asked how the change in the way that Oral Health services are to be paid will affect the service category. Garvin said they expect the expenses to increase. The rate of increase is said to have been low due to the cost per unit so it will now be paid as a cost per procedure and they aren't sure what that will look like since they have never done it that way. They do expect the cost to increase.
