Call to Order: Bobby Cruz, Co-Chair, called the meeting to order at 12:18 p.m. and asked for a moment of reflection.

Adoption of the Agenda: <u>Motion #1</u>: it was moved and seconded (Turner, Murray) to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of the Minutes: <u>Motion #2:</u> it was moved and seconded (Turner, Mica) to approve the June 23, 2022 minutes. **Motion carried.** Abstentions: Barr, Richards.

Public Comment and Announcements: Mica said that Texas is working to ban HIV care and PrEP provided by health insurance due to religious freedom. This is the same court that ruled that Obamacare was unconstitutional. There could be an increase in Ryan White clients if insurance is no longer providing HIV care.

Updates & Reports from the Ryan White Grant Administration: See attached reports included in the meeting packet. Martin said that no proposals were received for pediatric primary care and medical case management so there are unallocated funds in the amount of \$105,488 to be added to the carryover funds. There is also the balance of \$319,845 remaining from the increase scenario. The total amount available for reallocation today is \$1,308,752 and the three requests that were received total \$1,400,000. There is also a balance of \$273,335 in MAI funds but no requests were received. The agreement to use unallocated funds to reimburse ADAP for medications provided to clients in the Houston EMA is still in place.

Updates & Reports from The Resource Group: See attached reports, which were included in the meeting packet. Johnson said they had no updates.

Reallocate Ryan White Part A funds: The committee reviewed three requests for increased funds for Part A; no requests were received for MAI funds. See attached. They reviewed each request, made their final recommendations and justified their decisions (see the attached chart for details).

Allocation of FY 2021 Carryover Funds - MAI:

<u>Motion #3</u>: it was moved and seconded (Ledbetter, Murray) to use the FY 2021 Ryan White MAI carryover funds to reimburse the state ADAP program. **Motion failed.**

<u>Motion #4</u>: it was moved and seconded (Turner, Murray) to wait until the Fall committee meeting to allocate the FY 2021 Ryan White MAI carryover funds. Motion carried. Abstention: Murray.

Reallocation of FY 2021 Carryover and 2022 Unallocated Funds - Part A:

<u>Motion #5:</u> it was moved and seconded (Turner, Ledbetter) to fund the three requests in full less one third (\$30,416) of the overage (\$91,248) from each. See the attached chart for details. **Motion carried unanimously**.

Review of the Letter of Agreement with TDSHS:** See attached. Williams asked committee members to review the updated letter of agreement and send any suggested changes to her. She will send it to everyone in Word to mark changes on the document. It will be presented to the Operations Committee before going to the Council for final approval.

Announcements: Cruz said that the committee would not need to meet in August and September. In October, the committee will allocate unspent MAI funds. Martin said that the health department is hosting a town hall regarding monkey pox tomorrow, RSVP is required. Beck forwarded the flyer to all. Barr said that HOPWA will release a NOFA (Notice of Funding Availability) in the next 30 days. If you know of an organization that needs funds for case management or other support services please have them email her.

Adjournment: *Motion:* it was moved and seconded (Ledbetter, Murray) to adjourn the meeting at 1:01 p.m. **Motion Carried.**




