Legislative Update: Randall Ellis, Legacy Community Services Foundation, stated that the Senate and the House are committed to supporting a bipartisan bill and are not interested in the Coburn bill. Planning

Councils will probably not be eliminated under reauthorization. Key people in the process include: Texas Senators, Congressman Gene Green, Congresswoman Sheila Jackson Lee and Representative Culverson.

Orientation: On April 4, 2006, the Committee hosted a mini-orientation for all external committee members and Council members who were unable to attend the January 2006 all-day orientation.

Priority & Allocations Committee: Danny Garza, Co-Chair, made the following reports:

Meeting to Set the FY 2007 Priorities: The meeting where the Priority and Allocations Committee will create the recommended FY 2007 priorities has changed to: <u>10:00 a.m., on Thursday, May 18, 2006</u>.

Health Insurance and Local Medication Reimbursement: Motion 3: For FY 2006 only, HIV Services may transfer funds between the Health Insurance and Local Medication service categories as necessary to respond to the needs of PLWHA who are eligible for Medicare Part D (Medicare Rx) coverage without prior approval of the Planning Council. HIV Services must inform the Council within 45 days of any such shifts. Motion carried. Abstentions: Malone and Vargas.

Report from Office of Support: Kim, Health Planner, summarized the attached Manager's Report.

**Report from HIV Services**: Charles Henley, Director HIV Services, Harris County Health Department stated that there was no report from his office.

Report from the CDC Planning and Prevention Group: Robinson introduced the Community Planning Group (CPG) liaison, Brenda Booker Chapman. Chapman stated that the CPG is in the process of redefining their goals and committees and redistricting target populations. The CPG has 17 members and is recruiting an additional 35 members.

Mayor's Task Force on HIV/AIDS: Robinson stated that the Task Force had a retreat on March 31, 2006. The next meeting will be at the West Gray Multi-Purpose Center at 10:00 a.m. on April 21, 2006. Turner asked Robinson if he could get the minutes from the last Task Force meeting so they can be attached to Council minutes.

Latino Task Force on HIV/AIDS: Garza, D. stated that the last meeting was held on March 22, 2006. Director Steven Williams will be offering more support from the Health Department by providing a Co-Facilitator if the Task Force will provide more Hispanics in the different groups. The next meeting will be held at the Red Cross in Rosenberg on April 19, 2006.

HOPWA: Tuttle reported on the following: A HOPWA 101 document will be drawn up that will address constant questions. The Needs Assessment letter will be available for distribution soon. There is a Secret Shopper Program that assesses the level of services needed. The HOPWA RFP will be distributed on May 4, 2006. There will be a RFP Work shop on May 25, 2006 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. The next meeting will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 14, 2006.
