Call to Order: C. Bruce Turner, Chair, called the meeting to order at 12:10 p.m.

For the last two years, Cecilia Oshingbade has worked with committee co-chairs to provide Committee Cross Training which has been valuable to new members and others. He asked Cecilia if she would organize the training again this year, which will begin at 12 noon on Wednesday, September 18th. Soon, the

Office of Support staff will send detailed information about all three of the trainings. In the meantime, please let Tori know if you want to attend the training on September 18th. Turner stated that the visitors from HHS have been delayed due to a logistical issue and will hopefully be able join us next month. Turner then called for a Moment of Reflection.
